Wilson Air Test Facility Location

Andrew Winkelmay, Systems Engineer at WATC, requested support to locate the program's training test facility in Parking Lot S, north of the Anchorage Building. The test facility includes a 20'x20' covered area for test equipment, a 10'x10' control room, and a 10'x10' office.

A piece of land measuring 10' x 10' x 10' is available from the University of Alaska. The site seems to be the best location because of its close proximity and time to completion. Geophysical, insulation and thermal requirements will be met by the contractor. The cost of the land was discussed, but Winkelmay said it is an issue, as well as solar visibility.

WATC recommends approval of the request for the Wilson Air Test Facility in parking lot S, north of the Anchorage Building, with the following conditions:

- Facility to be demolished within one year of completion or earlier if no longer needed.
- WATC will either remove the equipment after three years or through the MPC.
- WATC will sign the lease with the University of Alaska for one year.
- WATC will occur every year and pay for three parking spaces.
- WATC will be consulted with EHS/IR, Engineering Services, and Facilities Services.
- WATC will be given continuous access.
- The training facility will be self-sufficient and will be disconnected from campus power.
