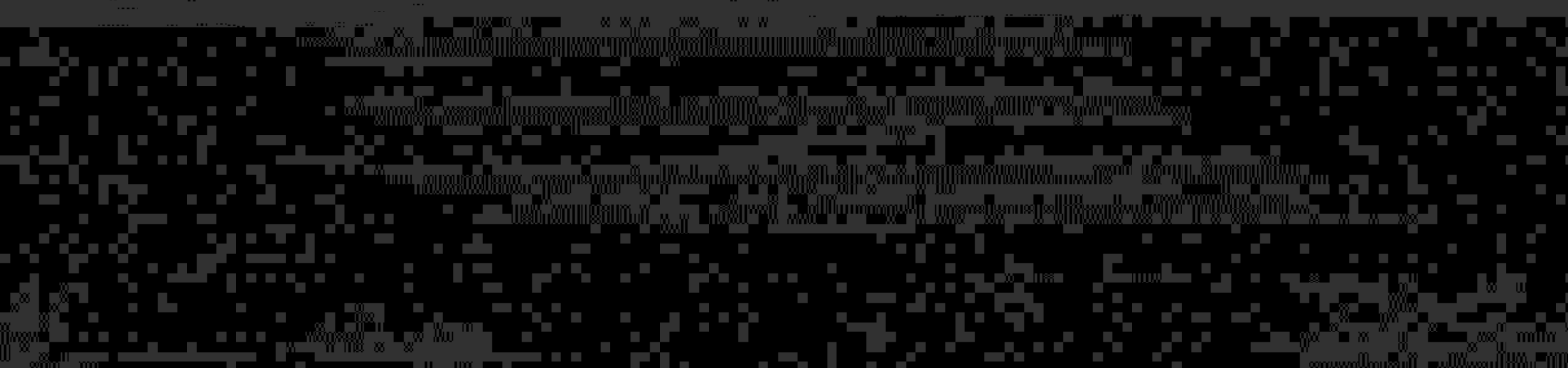

R04.06.010. Employee Education Benefits.

Employees, spouses and dependents shall incur no charges under the following conditions:

A. Dependence on the employee and their spouse shall be determined as follows:



J. Employees, spouses and dependent children must maintain a 2.0 or better cumulative GPA for the purpose of receiving graduate education benefits. Employees, spouses and dependent children must maintain a 2.0 or better cumulative GPA to be eligible for graduate level education benefits.
